





RTTY NEWS : Last month was a short discussion of the RTTY receiving unit and an example of a workable unit built from a "Phase-locked loop".

This issue we would present a "sending unit" RTTY is sent through the air over radio, but encoded as on and off pulses. These pulses are more easily decoded if they are sensed as audio tones at the receiving end, and therefore are usually sent at the transmitting end by way of tones into the microphone jack.

These tones, or frequencies, are shifted in step with the RTTY pulses, and are referred to as freq-shifting-keying or FSK. The characteristics of a good FSK unit are: 1. Stable tones, 2. Clean breaking tones (no slipping or skewing) and 3. A clean transient free, sine wave tone.

On the "not so stringent" end of these specs is the easy, two-transistor FSK unit for use only on the VHF type frequencies where AM or FM is used. This is described on page 36 of QST for September 1969. These tones can be fed right into the rig's mic jack and will be decoded at the receiving end. At "the best" end of the scale, is the AK-1 FSK generator marketed in kit form by Hal devices in Illinois. These tones are so pure that they can be fed into the mic jack of an SSB rig to give FSK on the "low bands". One word of caution: A phasing type of transmitter should NOT be used for this.





First, the good news ! The repeater has been moved to its new site at 1301 34th Street North. Our antenna is centered 210 feet above ground level on the Times Publishing Company tower. At this writing, after the first five days of operation at the new site, no intermodulation has been heard on the repeater! Perhaps we have laid Mrs Kalabash to rest. K4QCG and WA4IRA are trying to collect for her flower fund. Equal of better news is that we are not QRMING our neighbors on the tower.

Our coverage area has been extended so that a good mobile unit out in the clear can expect to get in from as far north as Weeki Wachi, east to Lakeland and south to Venice. Good base stations have come in from Floral City, Crystal River, Orlando, West Palm Beach and Fort Myers. Hand-held portables with rubber ducky antennas are useable in Pinellas County everywhere south of Dunedin, unless you are in a badly shielded location.

Reducing in-car interference to high-freq twoway radio equipment is a many-sided challenge. Aside from the primary problem areas there are many other lesser sources of noise which can be troublesome on occasion. It may be necessary, for example, to install a 1.0-mfd/200v. auto-generator type capacitor at the ammeter to prevent interference from feeding back to the battery and thence generally into the overall system. At the gasoline or oil-pressure guage, or the oil signal switch, a 0.1-mfd/100 V auto-suppressor or 0.5-mfd/200 V. generator-type capacitor, may be needed. One of the latter type capacitors may also be indicated for installation at the ignition switch. Beyond this, it may be necessary to install 1.0-mfd/200V. generator-type capacitors in connection with troublesome lights and accessories. Dont forget to bond the exhaust tail-pipe to the frame of the car.
